Building Fund

Helps build our new shelter, where not only the animals but staff and volunteers will be safer and healthier.

Emergency Medical Fund

Assists with care for dogs or cats with medical conditions that require a little extra time, attention, care, and finances. Each case that comes to us is unique—orthopedic issues such as broken bones or sprains, complicated and sometimes emergency surgeries, pets with heartworm disease, and much more.

Spay It Forward

MCFA's SNAP (Spay Neuter Assistance Program) pays an average \$55 to spay or neuter a dog or cat, providing free spay/neuter vouchers for local Monroe County residents.

Memorial

Donations dedicated to the memory of a beloved person or pet in your life.

General

Provides food, medicine, and veterinarian care at the shelter and funds MCFA programs such as rescue, spay/neuter, and Second Chance Pals.

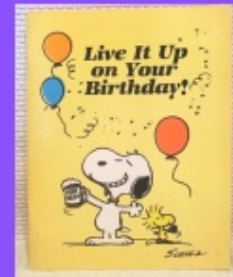

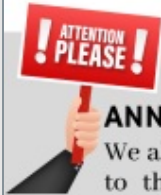
