

## Shelter Notice



Thanks to the quarantine imposed on the Monroe County Animal Shelter for the past two weeks due to an outbreak of upper respiratory illness in the canine population, and thanks to the shelter veterinarians, we were able to control the illness. We are now open for large and medium dogs as well as cats. As a precaution, we are still NOT accepting small dogs or puppies until Friday, March 3.

#### Shelter for outdoor dogs SB 195/HB 472

A bill to define "adequate shelter" for outdoor dogs has been introduced in both the House and Senate. The bill is being carried by Sen. Jon Lundberg and Rep. John Crawford. Co-sponsor: Darren Jernigan. The bill has been assigned to House Criminal Justice committee. The Senate version has been assigned to Senate Judiciary.

**How You Can Help** 

Connect with your state legislators and ask them to co-sponsor this bill. This will be an important show of support when the bill goes before committee. This bill will be heard in Senate Judiciary on March 14. Does your lawmaker sit on Senate Judiciary? If so, contact them and let them know you want them to vote YES with the bill comes before them in committee.
